This sound is a **trigraph**. A trigraph is three letters that make one sound.

Do you know how we pronounce this trigraph?

Can you think of any words that have this trigraph in?

Now try reading and answering these 'yes or no' questions.

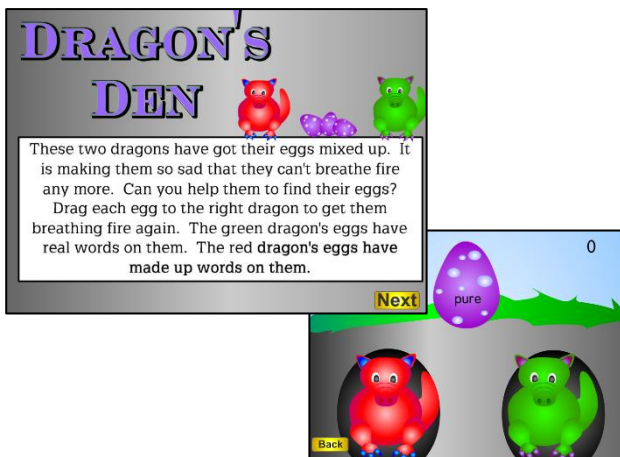


Will a farmyard be full of manure?
