School Dinners

We have received notification that the price of school dinners will be increasing from January 1st 2018 to £1.70 per meal. Children in Reception, Year One and Year Two will continue to be eligible for free meals under the Universal Free School Meals scheme. If you feel you may be entitled to Free School Meals, we encourage you to apply, irrespective of whether your child has a school meal or a packed lunch and whichever year group they may be in. If you are in receipt of certain benefits you will be entitled to Free School Meals which also means you will receive other benefits in school such as help with the cost of uniforms, some school trips, before and after school clubs and more. It is a very simple form to complete online with a result in seconds so it really is worth investigating. Our Office Staff can help you with the form. Please see our website for more details.

If we do decide to close school we will inform parents as soon as possible through the school website, our text service, the Bradford schools online website and local radio.
