## Easter Egg Competition

## Summer term Uniform

Our children have the option of wearing a slightly different uniform in the Summer term if they wish. Girls may wear a purple gingham summer dress or black pinafore dress. Boys may wear black school shorts. Boys and Girls may wear a school logo jumper or cardigan.
