Arrival at school

Attendance and Punctuality

I am pleased to inform parents that the overall attendance for Autumn Term 2017 was **96.2%**. The national average is 96%. All the children that achieved 100% in the Autumn term have received a certificate of recognition. Our Learning Mentor, Miss Walker will continue to monitor attendance and lateness, offering advice and support for those found to be persistently late for school or whose attendance falls below 90%.

We do appreciate that sometimes a child needs to attend a Hospital or Dental appointment during school time. Please bring the appointment letter to the School Office so that the absence can be recorded as a medical appointment. Can we ask that any other appointments such as Doctor or Eye tests are taken out of school time if at all possible as all appointments do affect your child's attendance percentage.
