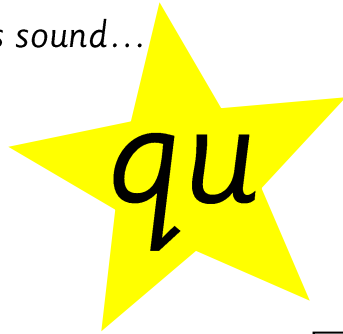


Phonics - Phase 3
