PE and Sports Grant for Academic Year 2016/17



Purpose of Funding (taken from DfE website)

Schools must use the funding to make additional and sustainable improvements to the quality of PE and sport they offer.

This means that you should use the premium to:

- develop or add to the PE and sport activities that your school already offers
- make improvements now that will benefit pupils joining the school in future years

For example, you can use your funding to:

- hire qualified sports coaches to work with teachers
- provide existing staff with training or resources to help them teach PE and sport more effectively
- introduce new sports or activities and encourage more pupils to take up sport
- support and involve the least active children by running or extending school sports clubs, holiday clubs and Change4Life clubs
- run sport competitions
- increase pupils' participation in the School Games
- run sports activities with other schools

Basis of Allocation

Allocations for the academic year 2016/17 are calculated using the number of pupils in Years 1 to 6, as recorded in the January census as follows:

Schools with 17 or more pupils receive £8000 plus £5 per pupil: and

Schools with 16 or fewer pupils receive £500 per pupil

For our school this is based on 344 pupils – and therefore a total allocation of £9,720 (£8,000 + (£5 x 344)).

This annual amount will be paid in two stages, with 7/12 for the autumn and spring terms paid in November 2016 (£5,670), and 5/12 for the summer term paid in May 2017 (£4,050)
