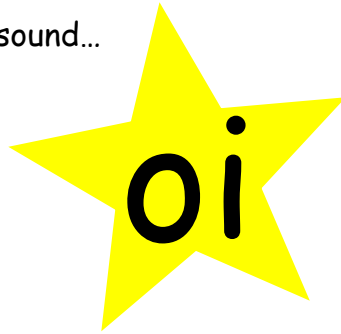


Phonics - Phase 3

Let's take a look at this sound...



This sound is a **digraph**. A digraph is two letters that make one sound.

Do you know how we pronounce this digraph?

Can you think of any words that have this digraph in?

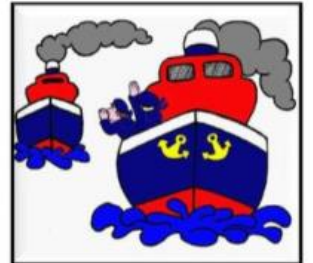
